

Practical Travel Suggestions

Getting to the Cité Internationale des Arts:

For the bold: From Charles de Gaulle airport walk to the nearby RER station. Buy a ticket for about \$15 at one of the machines with Paris as the destination. Depart the train at Gare du Nord. There is a taxi stand just outside the station (follow the icon signs). Hand the driver a printed card that reads “Cité Internationale des Arts, 18 Rue de l’Hôtel de ville” and you will be delivered to the front door. Cost for the taxi is approximately \$15.

For the convenience: There is a taxi stand at the airport. Hand the driver a printed card that reads “Cité Internationale des Arts, 18 Rue de l’Hôtel de ville” and you will be delivered to the front door. Cost for the taxi is approximately \$85.

Regional travel:

Purchase an SCNF (www.sncf-connect.com) Carte Avantage. If you make more than two trips on regional trains, the card will pay for itself with discounts on train tickets. Using this card, the difference in fare moving up from second to first class is often negligible, a real treat.
